#### Follow My Lead - Beginner \$109

Carol Hein-Creger presents this beginning class for all dogs 5 months and older who have not had structured training. Language & Leadership: Basic Obedience

Your dog will learn the basics such as heel, sit, wait/stay, down, and come, along with additional training and rehabilitation measures specific to your dog and family.
